Accepted Hazardous Materials Include

- ◆ **NO CHARGE** for house and garden pesticides, corrosives, cleaning products, solvents, pool chemicals, paints and stains, adhesives, fluorescent light bulbs, photography and hobby chemicals, propane tanks, aerosols, and products containing mercury.
- ◆ Microwaves and small appliances will also be accepted as scrap metal at **no charge**.

Accepted Electronics Collection Includes

- ◆ **NO CHARGE** for computer hard drives, computer monitors/computer terminals, cathode ray tubes (CRT), keyboards, laptops, medical electronics, printers, telephone equipment, televisions, typewriters, wire & cables and other miscellaneous electronics (i.e. VCR's, radios, DVD and CD players).

Items Not Accepted Include

- ◆ Ammunition & explosives, tires, waste (motor) oil, alkaline & lead batteries, smoke detectors, air conditioners, large appliances, medication and infectious waste, asbestos, construction & demolition debris, unsorted waste ("regular trash") or recyclables.
